- Today, Mahaveer Public School has achieved an all-round place among the schools across the world. Academic Excellence

Academic excellence has been our main objective where we don't leave any stone unturned and our Board result speaks volumes. I'm proud to say that in the session 2017-18 our students have proved their mettle by giving 100% pass result in CBSE Results of the classes X and XII.

In the session 2017-18 for class XII results:-

1. **In science stream Highest marks** were secured by **Master Daksh Rawat** with **96.6% in aggregate**.

2. In Commerce Master Naman Sanghi secured a huge total of **97.8%** which is the **highest ever in the history of Mahaveer Public school in class XII**. A whopping number of **23 students secured 90 and above percentage** of marks in aggregate and **06 students secured a perfect 100** in various subjects in class XII while in class X Board Exams as many as **25 students secured 90 and above percentage** of marks in aggregate and **36 students secured a perfect 100** in various subjects.

Many students have been chosen this year in the various prestigious IITs,IIMs and Law institutes through CAT across India.

These students brought laurels to their alma-mater, the honourable and visionary School Management has been always supporting and encouraging the emerging nobles who are leading and enhancing the glory of Mahaveer.

I am indeed happy to announce that many of the students will receive scholarships and cash awards worth 3,82,000 today by your gracious hand.

In class X Master Virendra Kabra who set an all time high record by achieving a never before total of **98.4 percentage of marks** which is the **2nd highest in the city of Jaipur** received a cash prize of **Rs. 51000** sponsored by **Shri Chandra Prakash Jain(Pahadiya) Chairman-Siddha group**. His proud teachers Ms. Suman Taneja, Ms. Achala Pareek, Ms. Deepti Nair, Ms. Saumini Panicker, Dr. B.C. Jain ,Ms. Shivani Sharma ,Ms.Rashi Srivastava ,Ms. Manisha Choudhary and Mr. Nitin Arora received a cash award of Rs. 5000 each and the School Principal was felicitated with cash award of Rs.6000.

2. In International Mathematics Olympiad our students won 8 Gold, 3 Silver and 3 Bronze medals.
