EXAMINATION & ASSESSMENT SCHEME

(As per the latest CBSE guidelines)

Examination are an integral part of the educational process. Evaluation is continuous and reveals the strengths and weaknesses of the learners frequently so that learners have better opportunity to understand and improve themselves. Our Examination System and Promotion Rules are consistent with the concept of evaluation developed by the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) and the policy envisaged by the Central Board of Secondary Education. The details about the system are as follows:

Class XI :

- *Students of Class XI will be given 02 formal unit tests, Half yearly and Final examination.*
- *Minimum pass percentage will be 33% (Separate in Theory & Practical Examination) in individual subjects as well as in aggregate.*
- *Students have to secure pass marks in the Unit Tests, Half Yearly & Final Examination separately. In case the aggregate percentage falls shorts of 33% due to absence in any (viz medical, emergency, outstation etc.) of the tests/exams the student will have to appear for the same in order to be promoted to the higher class.*
- *If a pupil fails for two years consecutively in the same class, he/she will not be allowed to continue for the third year and his/her name will be struck off from the school roll.*
- *Final Exam Answer Sheets will not be shown to Students, Parents or Guardians.*

Class XII :

The Central Board of Secondary Education holds Class XII Board Examination. All the policies of promotion are given in detail in the CBSE Examination Byelaws. Three formal examinations will be conducted during the session.

PROVISION FOR CHILDREN WHO ARE ABSENT IN TEST/EXAMINATION

- (i) *A separate test/Examination may be conducted for a child who could not appear in the Final Examination because of medical reason.*
- (ii) *The absence of a student from an examination other than Final Examination shall be condoned for medical reasons and for such absence, the student will be awarded no marks.*
